NEW YARD COMPLEX COMPLETED

Our latest building structure is now in use. It consists of an undercover area of 36 metres x 19 metres, seven spacious yards to comfortably hold 100 mares at any one time and a forcing yard and double crush for veterinary work.

The flow of the yards is excellent and we have a long laneway for the pony teaser to access mares in all of the yards.

The complex will be used mainly for dry mares, however the design has allowed for mares with foals, weanlings and yearlings to also be safely handled in the yards.

The undercover area will be fully floodlit to enable over 40 mares to be housed under lights from mid July to early September.

The complex has direct access to four paddocks totalling 600 acres in area and a laneway to access another two paddocks of 300 acres.
